

ASHRAE GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES

1. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot. If the selected shot is in the rough, all players must hit their shots from the rough.
3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
4. Putts need to be made from within 6 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
5. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
6. Men tee off from the blue tees and women from the white tees.
7. MULLIGANS are available for purchase at time of registration. These are available for \$1 per shot. Example: If everybody on your team wants to redo a shot, it will cost \$4. If one person wants to redo a shot, the cost is \$1. All mulligans must be purchased prior to the round and are used on the honor system. There is a maximum of \$20 total per team.

Golf Etiquette:

1. Please smooth all marks made in Sand Bunkers. This will be done with your feet as there are no rakes out.
2. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range but keep up with the group in front of you.
3. Balls may be cleaned on the green, and ball marks repaired prior to putting.
4. Please observe all local course rules.
5. Enjoy the day and your fellowship with other ASHRAE golfers!
